Derby Rules:

Each participant gets 10 swings or outs per entry fee. There will be three rounds of play for each group.

Round One:

All contestants bat, each player gets 10 outs per at bat; top 10 players advance, those with the most homeruns.

Round Two:

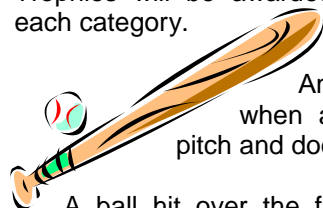
Top 10 contestants bat, each players gets 10 outs per at bat; top five advance. An out is registered when a player swings and does not hit a home run in fair territory

Round Three/Championship:

Top 5 contestants bat, each players gets 5 outs per at bat. The player with most home runs in the championship round is declared the winner.

Notes:

Trophies will be awarded to the **WINNER** in each category.



An "out" is registered when a player swings at a pitch and does not hit a home run.

A ball hit over the fence must be fair to count as a home run.

Since a home run does not count as an out, an infinite number of home runs is possible.

If there is a tie in any round, there will be a hit-off at the end of that round. In the hit-off, each player will get 3 outs and the player with the most home runs advances.

Home Runs do not carry over to the next round; each new round is a "fresh start."

Autism is a developmental disability, which usually begins before 3 years of age and is a life-long disability.

- The incidence of autism is approximately 1 out of every 100 births. **NJ is 1 in 94 births.**
- People with autism have normal life span.
- Autism is 4-5 times more prevalent in males than in females.
- Presently, there is no cure for autism. However, there are various treatment options to lessen the symptoms.
- Presently, there is no known single cause for autism.
- Research indicates that people with autism learn best through a structured environment.
- Autism occurs in all countries and within all socio-economic classes.

Research indicates that the earlier the intervention, the better for people with autism.
